1. Call Meeting to Order

Chairperson Calvin Slade called the meeting to Order at 430 pm.

2. Traditional Territory Acknowledgement

13. Pavenham Treatment

The Trustees considered various option for the upgrade to the Pavenham Station water treatment system.

Moved/Seconded to not proceed with the MSR, Magnor and Adedge proposals for the Pavenham treatment facility and proceed with the McElhanney proposal for the design, tender and construction administration services for the Pavenham treatment facility.

14. Leak Adjustment Request

Moved/Seconded that given the request does not fully fall within all of the parameters of the Leak Adjustment Policy, Cowichan Bay Waterworks will apply some forgiveness for the mainline, plumbing, and landscaping water leaks by if the adjusted outstanding amount is paid within thirty [30] days of the Board meeting.

The Trustees reviewed draft Bylaw 363 – Water Conservation. The District Administrator will add additional sections regarding criteria, notice and the remedied default.

16. Island Savings Bank Breach

Cowichan Bay Waterworks District was verbally advised of a bank breach at Island Savings [name, address, account number and bank balance]. No personal information was disclosed. A formal letter will be coming. Our account is flagged. Staff changed passwords and set up additional notifications as recommended by our Advisor.

It was noted that the Scada server was upgraded at the Office last week, providing for additional security measures.

17. Five Year Capital Plan

The Trustees received the draft Five Year Capital Plan.


18. Finance Officer Report

Moved/Seconded to receive the June 2023 Water Operator Report and the Stage 2 and 3 water use data.

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It was noted that water use has dropped since the tiered water rates were revamped after the record high usage in 2021. The District Administrator was directed to increase public information regarding the 2023 Water Use Restrictions. Generally water consumption is in keeping with the water restrictions, as evidenced by the brown lawns, however, violations are still occurring, as evidenced by the green lawns.

20. New Connections / Ongoing Developments

The Trustees reviewed the subdivision applications at 1780 Vee Rd and 1531 Cowichan Bay Rd. The District Administrator will prepare a Charter/Roles and Responsibilities document outlining costs, expectations and the development process.

Moved/Seconded to request McElhanney adjust priorities and review the development proposals for 1780 Vee Rd and 1531 Cowichan Bay Rd.
