ONGOING STAGE 3 WATER RESTRICTIONS

You may have noticed that surrounding districts have started lifting their water restrictions.

The District has carefully reviewed our water production volumes, up to and including usage into the early days of October. Although our current daily production has recovered from the highs of the summer, it remains in excess of our water allocation set by the province. The limitation on our water licensing allocation was discussed at the 2025 AGM.

As such, we have made the difficult decision to maintain our Stage 3 Water Restrictions indefinitely. We are actively pursuing dialogue with the province and advocating for the water licensing needs of our community – both to meet existing needs and to accommodate future growth.

We appreciate the community's understanding in this decision and thank you for your continued measures towards water conservation.
