## **Terms of Reference**

## Committee of the Whole, Cowichan Bay Waterworks District

- 1. A Committee of the Whole is established as a standing committee.
- 2. The Committee shall meet at the call of the Chair, generally the week before the regular board meeting.
- 3. The Committee shall consist of all Trustees, with a quorum being three Trustees.
- 4. Attendance by all Trustees is not mandatory.
- 5. The Chair shall be elected by the Committee at the first meeting after the Annual General Meeting.
- 6. The purpose of the Committee of the Whole shall be a working committee, providing opportunity to discuss and debate matters and services in a less formal structure than at a regular board meeting. Any motions will be forwarded for approval at the next regularly scheduled board meeting.
- 7. A matter in which consensus cannot be reached shall be referred to the next board meeting.
- 8. Minutes shall be recorded by the District Administrator, distributed, considered and ratified at the following board meeting.
- 9. Specific matters that the Committee of the Whole shall from time-to-time include:
  - 9.1. Water operations reporting
  - 9.2. Budget planning
  - 9.3. Special projects [e.g., Master Plan, Source Water Protection Plan, new well planning, long term planning, audit report, annual budget, policy development]
  - 9.4. Other matters that may require in-depth consideration
- 10. Delegations and Petitions may be considered at the Call of the Chair.
- 11. Meeting rules and procedures will be in accordance with Meeting Procedure Bylaw 331.
- 12. These Terms of Reference shall be reviewed by the Committee annually, generally after the Annual General Meeting.
